FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN...

“FOR I KNOW THE PLANS I HAVE FOR YOU...”

Among the words of God spoken through the prophet Jeremiah were these beautiful words of hope and promise to his people who found themselves at an important crossroads in their lives as God's people. Some years earlier the people of God were led into captivity of the rival Babylonians. Wondering if they would ever see and know the favor of God again in their lives, God brings these words of guidance and hope. To see the breadth of God's promise, take in the fullness of what God has in mind:

For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart. (Jeremiah 29:11-13 NIV)

At significant points in my own spiritual journey I have often turned to this specific promise in God's word. When I've needed guidance, reassurance, and God's wisdom in making an important decision, I've sought the counsel of these verses. Perhaps you do as well.

As 2010 begins, I find myself drawn to these words again because I believe this will be a significant year in our life and work together. Alongside the work of our ministry teams and committees, we will be discussing important matters of transition and change as we envision life and ministry in new ways and new places. We'll be discussing plans and possibilities that may excite us or concern us. Sometimes the thoughts of changes are hard. I know that. When it feels as though an important aspect of our lives is being turned upside-down, our emotions and anxieties can get the better of us.

That is why in the midst of all our planning and preparations, it is important to remember that God himself has plans in mind for us here at Waterville UMC as well. Accomplishing God's will and purpose individually and collectively are the most important things we can fulfill together no matter what the future holds.

Can we know what plans that God has for us? Yes! How can we discern the difference between plans we make and the plans God makes? The answer, says Jeremiah, lies in the power of prayer. As we sincerely, diligently, deliberately seek God together, he says we will find him and his will.

I want to challenge you with this thought: What if these very words of Scripture became the basis of our work this year? What might happen if we made these “life verses” for our congregation? I believe God is going to do some extraordinary things in the months that lie ahead, and I am very much looking forward to seeing them fulfilled as we seek God’s design and desire in our congregation and community.

Thanks to each of you for being an invaluable part of God’s mission and ministry. Your hands and hearts are making such a difference in so many lives. It is indeed a great privilege to be called your pastor.

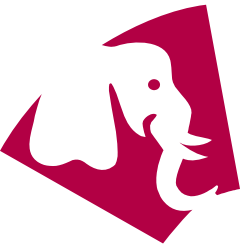

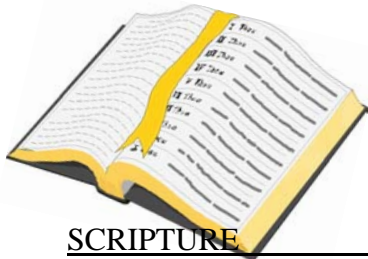
